

Method of organizing events

- > Events arising out of monthly group meetings, decisions are approved by the HOD
- ➤ There are 4 groups, and it is mandatory for all groups to have at least one event per month.
- ➤ In the months leading up to the University exams or other unavoidable circumstances, the club may decide whether to postpone the proceedings or not to postpone the proceedings at a meetingbased on majority opinion.
