Eligibility Criteria for Nomination

- 1. The applicant must be from the female staff (Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff) or Girl student of the college.
- 2. They shall provide necessary documents at the time of application.
- 3. The application from the staff and students shall be given with the signature of Head of the department. In the case of non teaching staff, the office superintend shall forward the application.

Screening Committee and a Selection Committee

Screening Committee and a Selection Committee would be constituted for the purpose which shall consider the achievement of individuals nominated or recommended for the Puruskars by the prescribed authority. The outstanding contributions in the field shall be of primary consideration in identifying the recipients of Puruskars.
