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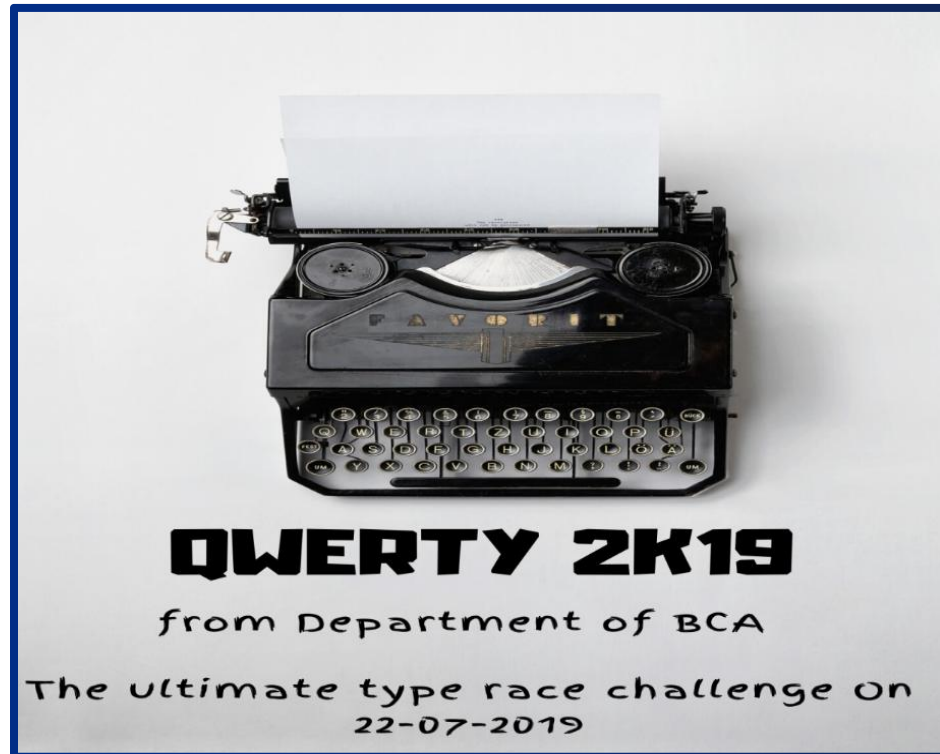

Programme report:

Department of Computer Studies conducted an ultimate type race challenge on 22th July 2019 named **QWERTY 2K19** for all students in Navajyothi College irrespective of departments. It was conducted at BCA Computer Lab.2 representatives from each class,a total of 28 students from UG and 8 students from PG have participated in this competition. Mrs Honey Johnson ,Assistant Professor in the Computer Studies department took the initiative to lead this challenge.

Speed and time are always related. Typing speed is calculated according to the most widely accepted method where a 'word' is assumed an average of 5 characters (spaces included) with every error (per minute) being a 1 WPM deduction. Nearly all other significant statistics are also reported, allowing for a more custom calculation as well. All performance calculations are also clearly explained (simply mouse-hover over the labels) making it easy to understand your results.

There was two rounds' semi-finals and finals. Semi-finals were conducted with a duration of 15 minutes which include graphs and texts with subscripts, superscripts, digits, roman numbers etc. The final round is all about how fast you are.
