
The academic year 2021-2022 began with a strategic overview meeting with an aim to improve academic and non-academic performance of department, the meeting evaluated the result of first outgoing batch, and decided to make necessary changes in the academic matters. The annual report of this year in review reflects in a variety of ways how the department has connected to its vision.

With respect to students, the focus was to introduce new teaching methodology that would engage them more thoroughly and enhance the learning experience. Many students–centric initiatives were introduced. The peer learning system was introduced for all the classes. Advanced learners were identified as group leaders to facilitate learning of group members within and outside classrooms. This peer learning exercise proved to be advantageous in two ways- firstly the students benefitted from the collaborative and cohesive learning and secondly the teachers were able to focus on mentoring. Student mentoring and attendance follow was continuously monitored by all class teachers which reflected in their attendance percentages and performance in examinations, and a comprehensive curriculum revision was undertaken in 2021-2022 academic year for all papers, special coaching and remedial classes were arranged which in turn helped the students to clear the papers and complete the programme within the time period.

The year progressed with a blend of curricular and co-curricular and cultural activities. National Seminar, Debate competition, mobile photography competition, quiz

competition, discussion on budget, fresher's day celebration, Diwali celebration were organized by the department this year.


INTERNATIONAL JUSTICE DAY-ONLINE DEBATE COMPETITION



RHYTHM -WELCOME PARTY


