Academic Report 2021-22

The world has been undergoing through a catastrophic pandemic situation due to the wide spread of COVID -19 for the last two years. Global and regional lockdown have adversely affected the entire system that we have been following. In spite of all the state of affairs were unfavourable, we have some rays of hope in the rise of technological development and adapting to the new alternatives. The face to face lecturing has been turned to the online mode of teaching for the last two years. However, we have had three months of offline classes in the academic year 2020-21. The college has begun the academic year 2021-22 in the month of June on online mode as per the government rules. Due to COVID pandemic, the new admission to the fist year degree and PG programmes were late and the off line classes were started on 25th October 2021. We have 537 students and 39 teaching staff and 13 supporting staff in the college.
