In 2013 B.Com Co-operation, BA English Literature with Journalism, and M.Com finance were added to the courses offered by the college. Later years M.Com Marketing, MA English, BA Economics, and B.Com Finance were added to the existing course.

From the beginning, the students of Navajyothi were guided and motivated to excel both in academics and co-curricular activities. When the first batch completed their courses, the college bagged the university ranks in various courses to date. The management is focused on training the students both in the curricular and cocurricular activities of the students. Faculty Development Programme

A one-day faculty development programme on Values in Education was conducted at Navajyothi College, Cherupuzha on 16th June 2017. It was aimed to enhance the faculty competencies for imparting values among students. The programme was attended by 33 faculties of the college.

The programme started at 10.00 A.M. with a prayer. The welcome address was delivered by the Principal, Prof. Lillikutty Chacko, who stressed the role of teachers to establish and maintain clear standards of behaviours among students. In his Presidential address, Rev. Fr. Siby Joseph, Director of the college, emphasized the important educational process that instils moral standards to create more civil and democratic societies. The FDP was inaugurated by Rev. Dr Biju Antony with the lighting of the lamp. The programme was felicitated by Mrs Aney Suphalmma N Mathew from BCA and Mrs Rajitha K. of the Malayalam Department.

After the inaugural session, Rev. Dr Biju Antony gave a lecture on Values in Education. He focused on the importance of value in education, its objectives, the role of teachers, and the role of society. Huge discussion followed thereafter. Rev. Dr Biju requested some of the participants to present their views on the methods of imparting value-oriented education. Mr Priyesh Kumar P.V. from English Department presented his thoughts.

Rev. Dr Biju described the three methods- direct; indirect; informal/incidentalin detail. He emphasized the role of teachers and advised the participants to be a model to the students. He also talked about the key source of values and the reasons for the value crisis. During the session, he highlighted the importance of values in the context of the Indian Education System. He added that it helps both the teachers and students know the purpose of their lives and become more responsible and sensible. After the lunch break, faculties discussed the approaches to nourish higher values among students with the speaker and themselves. Re. Dr Biju pointed out the major approaches and explained them in detail. He advised the teachers to adopt better teaching method strategies for implementing value-based education. Mr Stebin Antony, Department of Management Studies, and Ms Jeena P.B. Department of Hindi put forward their feedback. The vote of thanks was proposed by Mr Ragesh K.V., Staff Secretary.
