Faculty Development Programme

A one-day Faculty Development Programme on **Effective Communication and Interpersonal Skills at Workplace** was conducted at Navajyothi College, Cherupuzha on 23rd January 2021. It was aimed to discover useful communication strategies for the workplace. The programme was attended by all the faculties of the college.

The programme started at 10.00 A.M. with a prayer. The welcome address was delivered by Mrs Simna Simon, who stressed that interpersonal skills are important for communicating and working with groups and individuals in our personal and professional life. In his presidential address, Dr Aravindan, Principal, emphasized that people with strong interpersonal skills can build good relationships and can work well with others. Rev Fr. Sijoy Paul Karingalichira, the Director, introduced the guest. The FDP was inaugurated by Mr Jim Varghese with the lighting of the lamp. The programme was felicitated by Sr. Roselin from the Department of Commerce and Ms Hema from the Department of Hindi.

After the inaugural session, Mr Jim Varghese gave a lecture on Effective Communication and Interpersonal Skills at Workplace. He focused on the importance of interpersonal skills, examples of interpersonal skills, and how to improve interpersonal skills. During the session, he gave the task of reading and listening newspaper. Through the task, he explained the different modes of communication. 6

To make awareness about different styles of communication, he showed one video regarding the topic. Faculties are asked to present different contexts for aggressive, passive, and assertive styles of communication. He pointed out the relevance and need to develop assertive skills. He added that being assertive means taking care of ourselves. He took classes on examples of interpersonal skills.

After the lunch break, faculties are requested to sit in groups and discuss the barriers to communication. Along with each groups' presentation, Mr Jim Varghese explained it in detail. He advised the teachers to adopt better interpersonal skills and practice the skills for improving communication skills at the workplace. Mr Nelson Jose, Department of Management Studies, and MrsGowri Mohan, Department of English, put forward their feedback. The vote of thanks was proposed by MsPriya K, Staff Secretary.

Faculty Development Programme for Non-teaching Staff

Navajyothi College Cherupuzha organised the one-day Faculty Development Programme for non-teaching staff on **Effective File Management** on 20th June 2020. The programme started at 10.00 A.M. with a prayer. The dignitaries on the stage were Dr Aravindan M, Principal Navajyothi college, Rev.Fr.Sijoy Paul, Director of the college, Fr TinoPampackal (GM, Wam Tea) and MrStenil George Asst. Prof, Department of Commerce.

Dr Aravindan M welcomed all the dignitaries on the dais and participants. Rev.Fr. Sijoy Paul presided over the function. He emphasized the importance of effective file management. Rev. Fr. Department of Management Studies

Department of Management Studies, NavaJyothi College successfully conducted various academic and non-academic activities during the academic year 2020 – 2021.
