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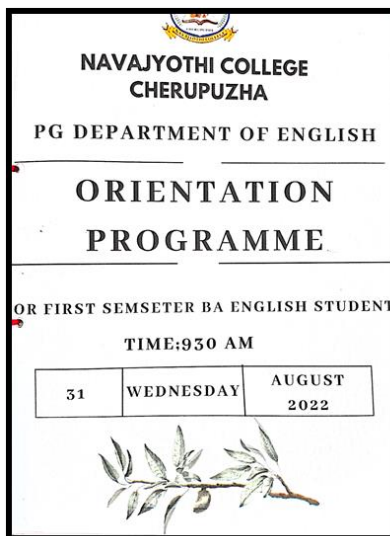

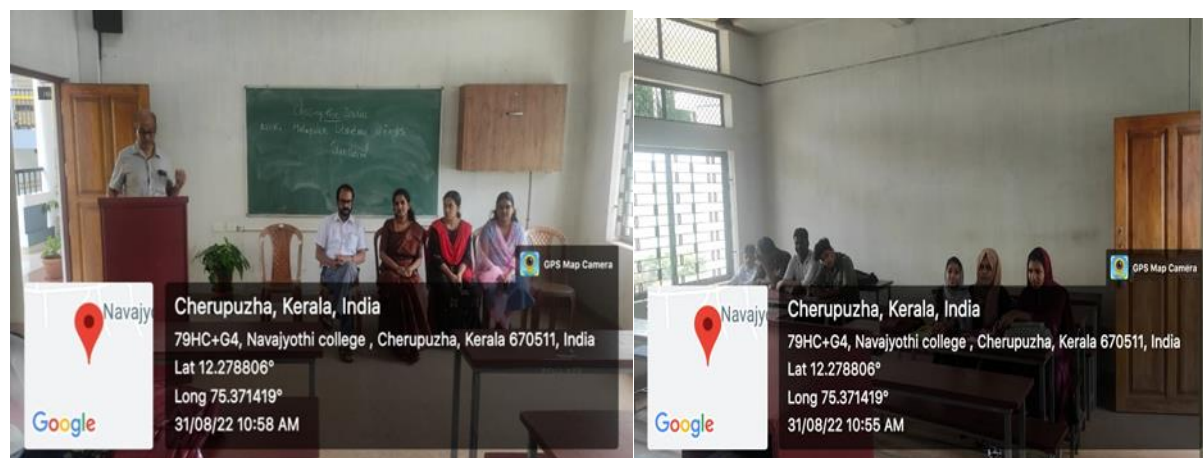

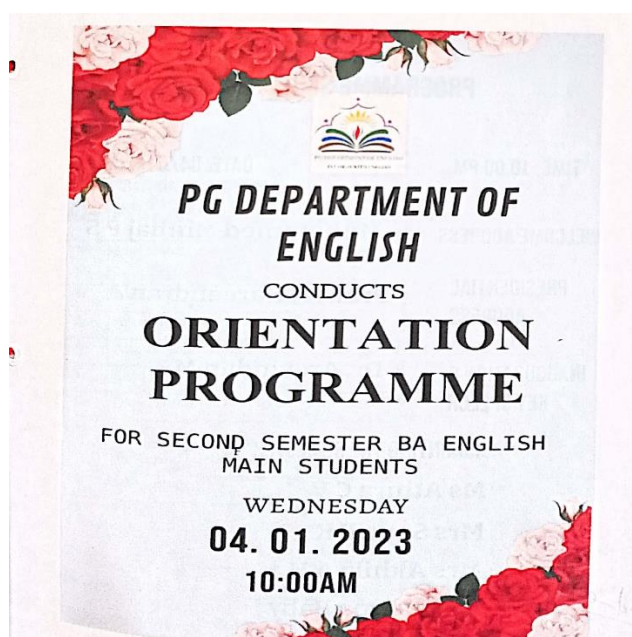
FIRST SEMESTER INDUCTION PROGRAMME REPORT 2022- 2023

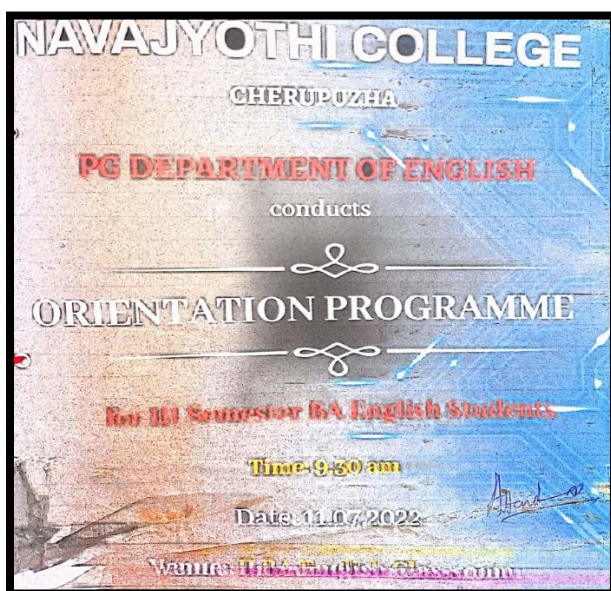
SECOND SEMESTER ORIENTATION PROGRAMME REPORT 2022- 2023

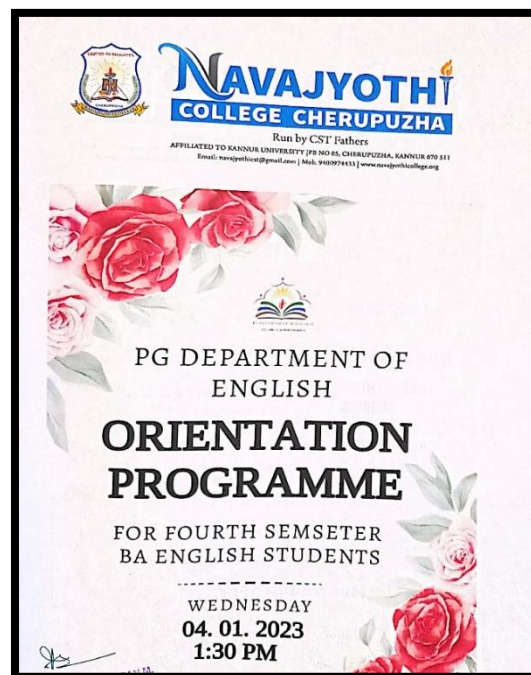
THIRD SEMESTER INDUCTION PROGRAMME REPORT 2022- 2023



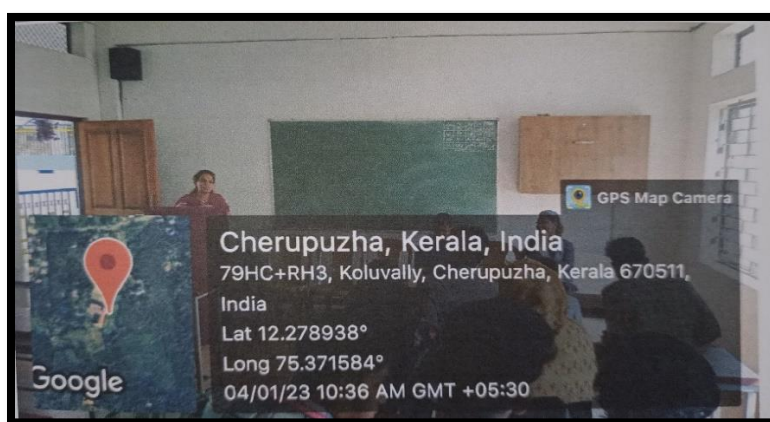

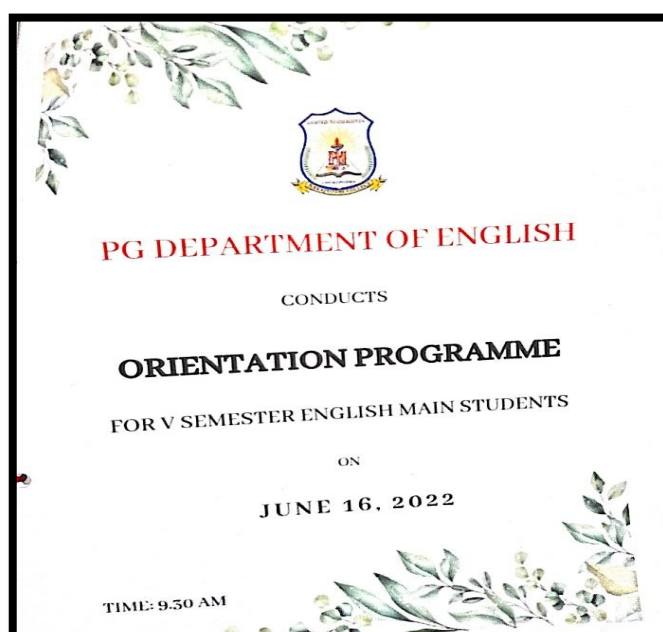
FOURTH SEMESTER INDUCTION PROGRAMME REPORT 2022- 2023

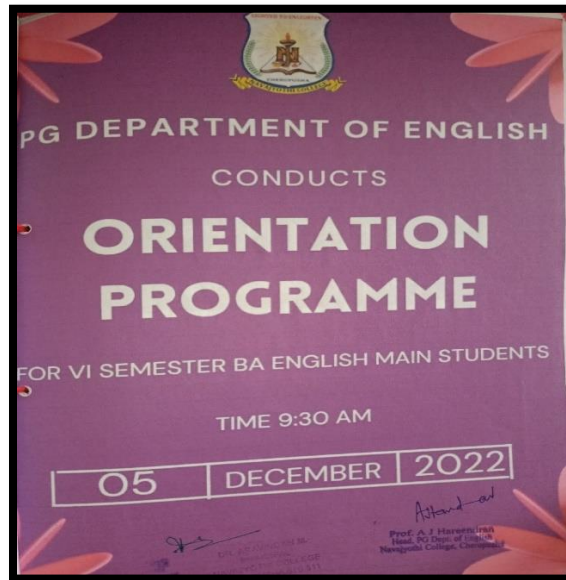
FIFTH SEMESTER INDUCTION PROGRAMME REPORT 2022- 2023

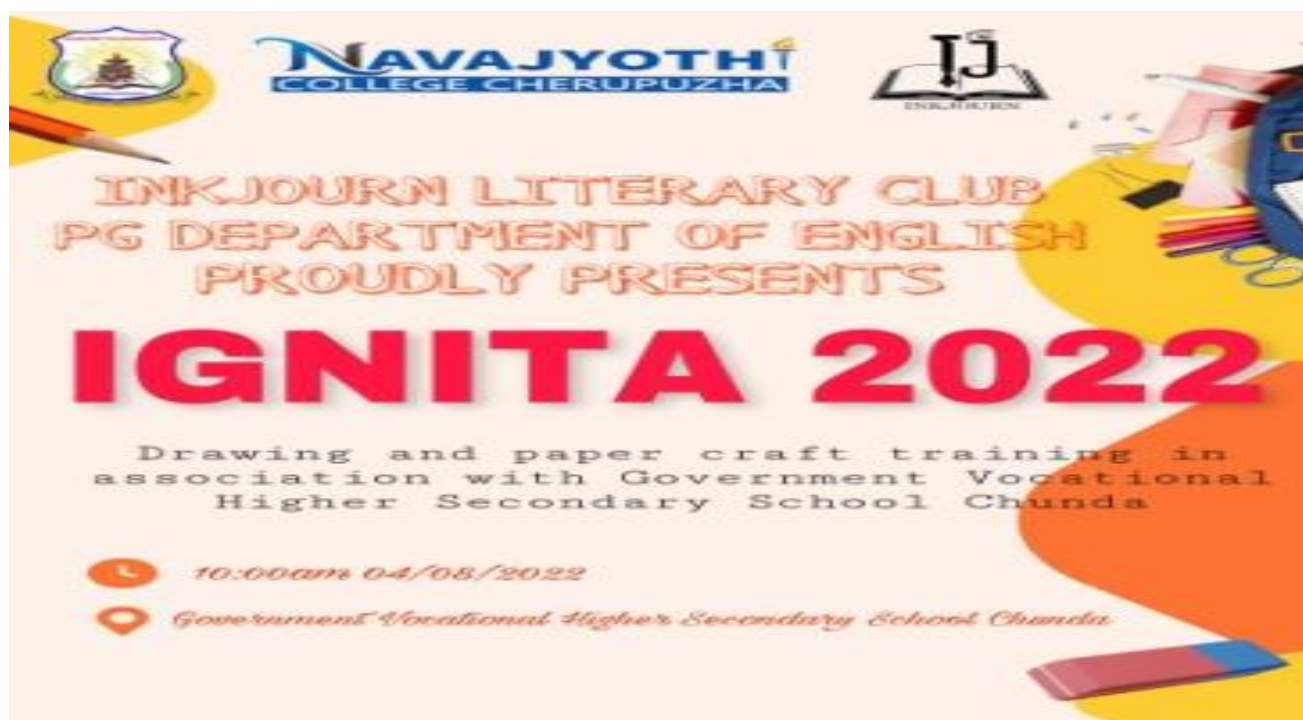

3.1 IGNITA

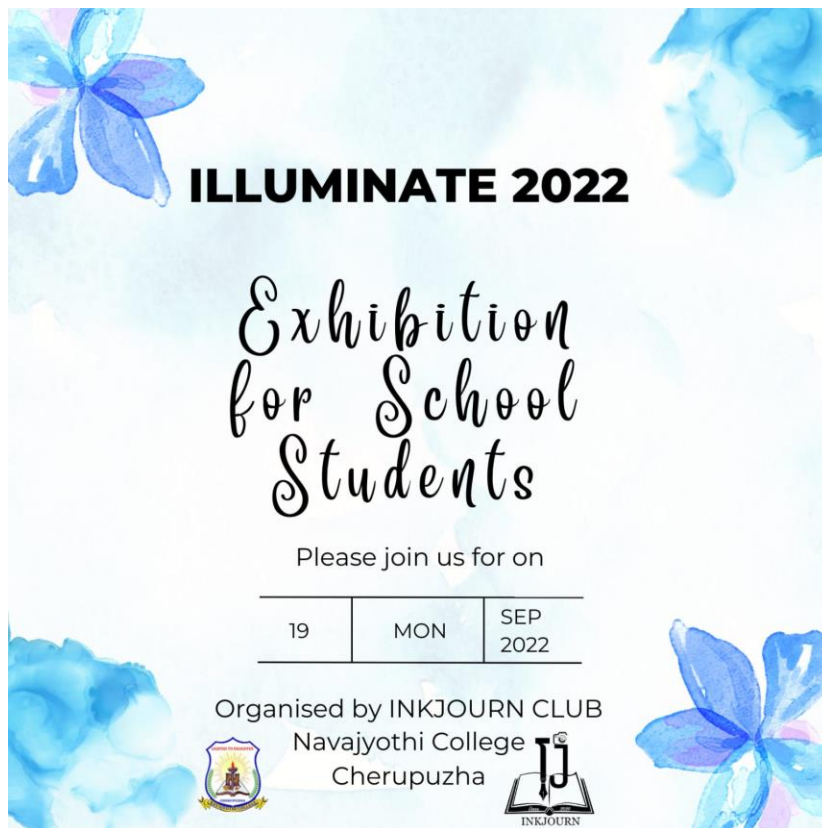

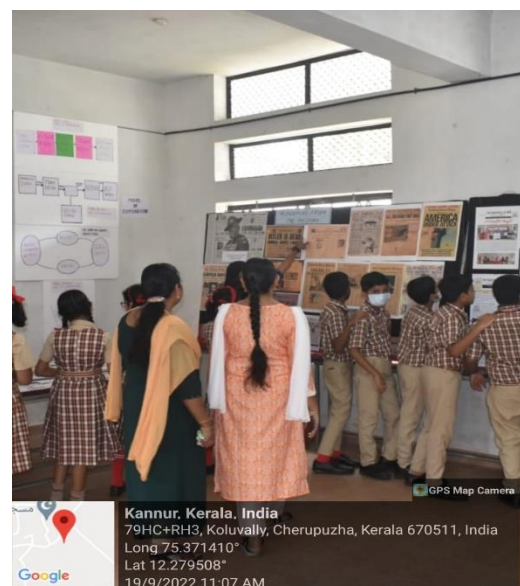


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3.2 ILLUMINATE

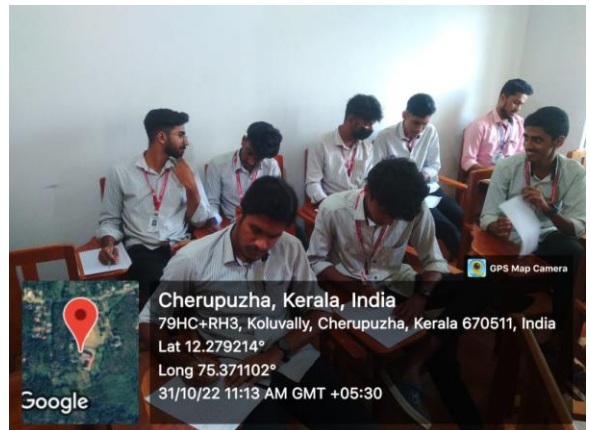

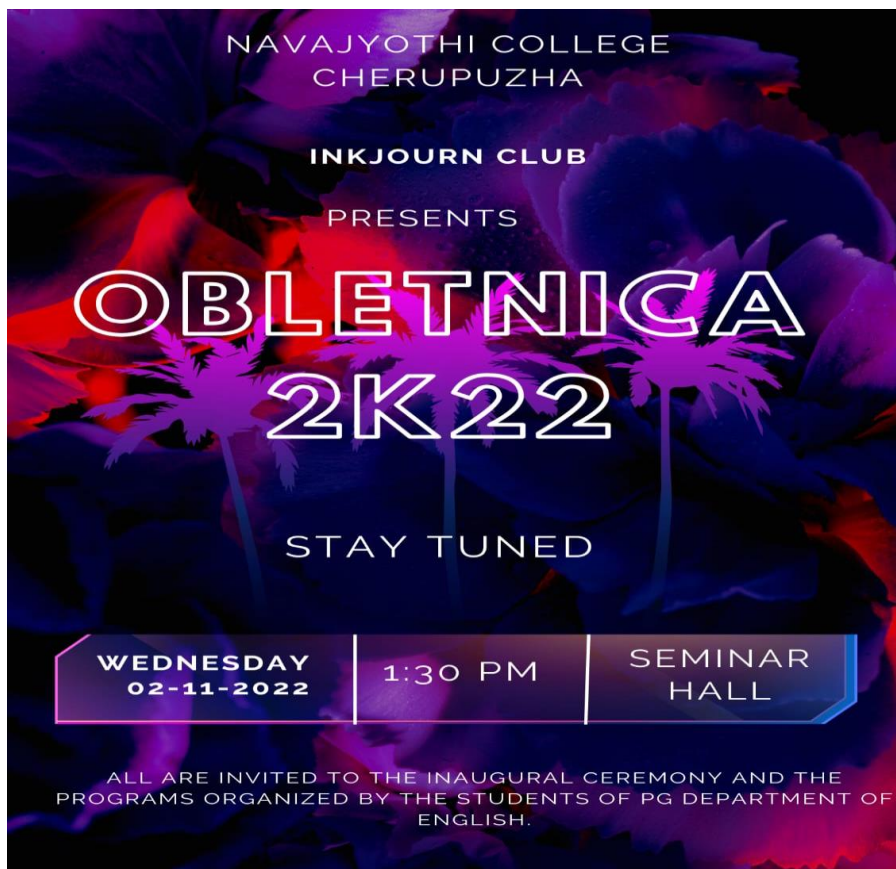

INKJOURN NAVAJYOTHI COLLEGE

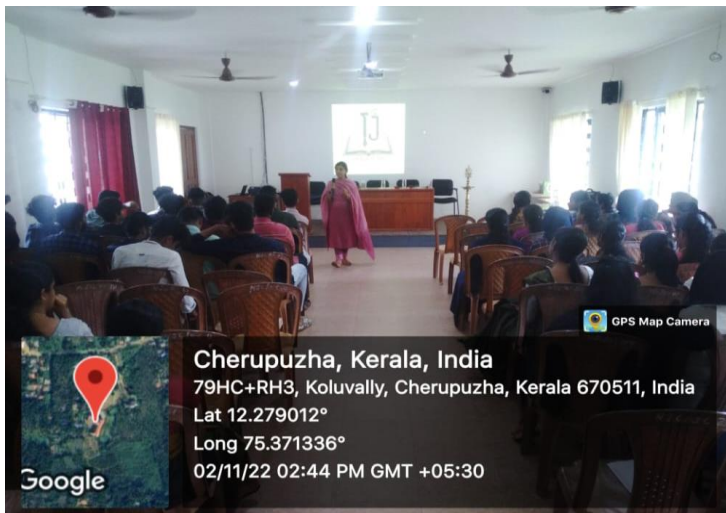

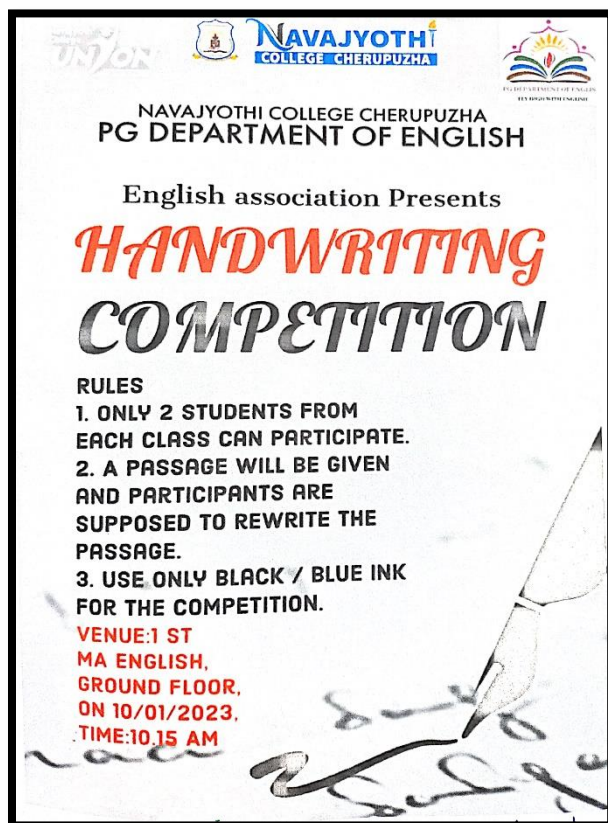
3.6 MEDIA VISIT

3.1 Handwriting Competition



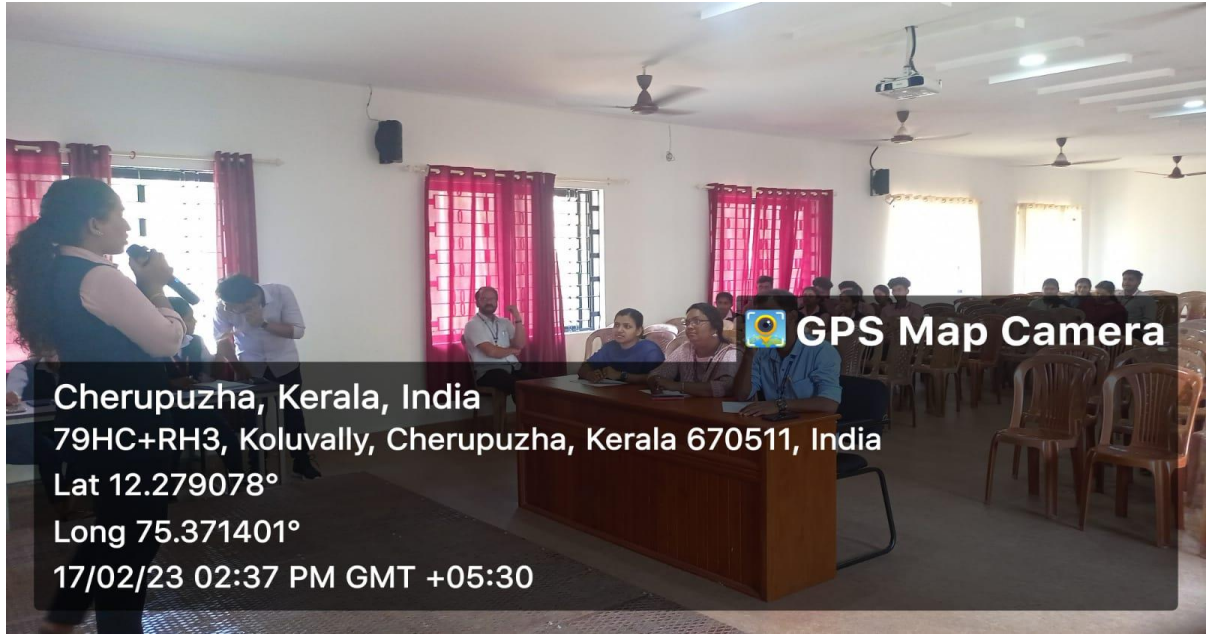

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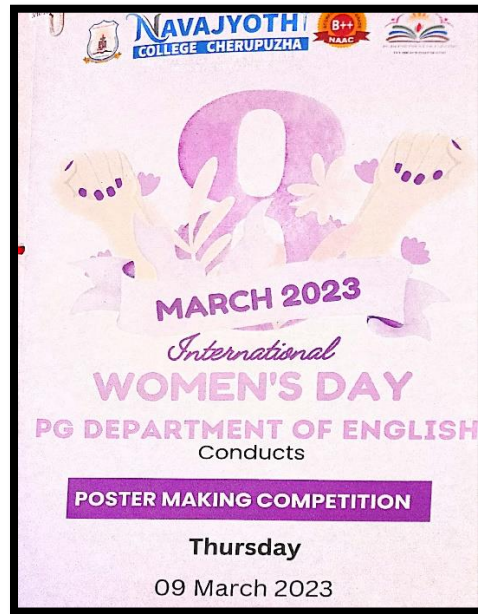


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3.2Poster Making

4. LANGUAGE LAB PROVIDED FOR UG STUDENTS



Language lab offered classes for UG students from each department after the class time from 3.15 to 4.00pm. LANGUAGE LAB CERTIFICATE COURSE FOR THIRD YEAR UG STUDENTS

As a part of Certificate course, PG Department of English provided Language Lab Certificate Course for III year UG students. The classes offered a course on the topics such as basics of grammar, LSRW (Listening, Speaking, Reading, Writing), Soft skills and Life skills. This was a 30 hour long class.

After the completion of the course we conducted examination based on the prescribed syllabus. We also conducted retest for those who did not attend the examination. The exam tested students knowledge on grammar, and included a reading section for testing their pronunciation.



LANGUAGE LAB CERTIFICATE COURSE FOR SECOND YEAR UG STUDENTS

PG Department of English offered Language Lab certificate course for second year UG students. A detailed syllabus is prepared for the course based on the topics such as basics of grammar, phonetics, listening, speaking, reading, writing, life skills and soft skills. The class lasted for 30 hours. After the completion of classes there was an examination for the students. This was conducted in the mode of online examination and tested students' reading skills and pronunciation also.



LIFE SKILLS AND SOFT SKILLS CLASSES FOR FIRST YEARS

Language lab classes for first year students started with the intention to provide life skill and soft skill classes. The class focused mainly to build students confidence in spoken skills and a group collaboration and cooperation. To develop the speaking skill of the students, we were provided different types of spoken activities during the language lab class hour, like self-introduction, extempore speech etc. In a constantly changing environment, having life skills is an essential part of being able to meet the challenges of everyday life. After the completion of the class, the examination conducted as per the class provided. The examination included speaking and online objective type questions.
