2.1. GENERAL ORIENTATION FOR STAFF 2.1.1 FIVE-DAY FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME (8th June to 14th June 2022)

IQAC of Navajyothi College, Cherupuzha organized a Five-Day Faculty Development Programme for the new teaching staff from 8th June 2022 to 14th June 2022. The programme was venued at the Seminar Hall of the College from 1.30 to 4 pm.

On 8th June, the first day of the FDP, Dr Fr John Kochupurakkal CST, Manager, NJC delivered an introduction to 'Policies and Strategies in Education Mission'. Dr Aravindan M, Principal, NJC elaborated on 'Teaching Profession: Duties and responsibilities on 9th June. Mr Shijo Jose, Head of the Department of Management Studies and Mr Eby Jose, Convener of internal examination handled the session on 'Responsibilities of Teachers in Curricular and Co-curricular activities and duties on 10th June. On 13th June the session was about 'NAAC Accreditation: An Introduction to Policies and Practices of NJC' handled by the recourse persons Mrs Simna Simon, IQAC Coordinator and Mr Mathew M J, Head, PG Department of Commerce. 
Our PG students and faculties presented papers during international seminar organized by Nehru Arts and Science College .

2.5. SKILL DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES FOR STUDENTS

NJC IQAC always focuses on imparting skills to the students through various activities. Student's IQAC and SAIN et al play a major role in it.During the academic year 2022-23 the following activities were conducted to empower our students

2.5.1. Theatre Workshop

The IQAC of the college organised a theatre workshop for the students from 17 th October to 20 th October 2022, to develop their inborn capacities of acting. The workshop was led by Mr Vijesh Kari, a renowned playwright and director from Cheruvathoour. He has trained the students in the basics of theatre acting and various modes of street play. By the end of the three days programme, the students were able to perform a street play. The street play was based on the theme of the drug abuse o in society The students performed the play at various places as a part of the state government's campaign against drug abuse.

2.5.2. CHAMPIONS DAY

A workshop on soft skills was organised by IQAC from 07/10/2022 to 08/10/2022. The sessions were handled by Miss. Nimisha Balakrishnan a research scholar in Bharathanatyam and Mr.Adarsh Vadakara. They have arranged a lots of spontaneous programmes to overcome the stage fear of the students. Training sessions for classical dance, songs, and other dance styles were held. The

2.5.3. WIZARDRY : Workshop in skill development

Navajyothi College IQAC, in collaboration with BCASA (club of Department of Computer Studies), conducted a workshop on MS Word WIZARDRY as part of SAIN et al skill development initiatives. At the workshop, 40 students from various department took part. The BCA department's faculties and students trained the enrolled students. Based on the syllabus, this workshop covered practically every aspect of Microsoft Word. Upon finishing the session, participants were given an assignment as part of the training.. The certificates were distributed after the successful completion of the workshop. The programme was highly influential and informative to all the participants. The information gathered from the feedback was evaluated and it showed that the workshop provided a favourable setting for the candidates to study more about Microsoft Word applications.



2.6 LANGUAGE LAB
